Phone 707-863-3480 Fax 707-864-5856 Per Section XI of the Laborers Master Agreement The general contractor is liable for payment of fringe benefits on behalf of any laborer hired by the subcontractor in the event said subcontractor fails to pay the contributions due.

1. Request a Project Status Letter from LFAO to confirm the subcontractor is reporting and paying fringes on the project.

2. Inquire with LFAO if they have received the certified payroll records for the project and can confirm if ALL of the hours have been reported and paid accordingly. If cpr's have not been submitted to LFAO, you can submit them to receive such confirmation.
